Wawa Receives Over \$350,000 from NOHFC



The Ontario Government is providing more than \$350,000 through the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation

(NOHFC) for updates to the airport terminal and Michipicoten Golf Course. "The Municipality of Wawa thanks NOHFC for its financial contribution to the Wawa Municipal Airport upgrades. This critical funding will support terminal building improvements and make accessible its washroom facilities, as well as purchase a sand dome for improved runway operations. The airport provides a critical service to the community, including Alamos Gold Inc., who has also contributed to this project." said Mayor Pilon. The Municipality acknowledges and thanks Alamos Gold Inc. for also making a financial contribution to the project. Funding provided to

support the needed repairs to the golf course clubhouse, accessible decking and irrigation pump, will ensure residents and visitors can golf and have access to the clubhouse.

The golf course attracts and retains visitors to the community, contributing to the local economy and, with the support of NOHFC, will be around for years to come. The Municipality was proud to obtain this funding for the golf course.

On Monday, June 17, 2024, MPP Michael Mantha visited Wawa to announce that the Municipality of Wawa was successful in receiving a Community Investment Grant from the



Ontario Trillium Foundation for a safe running and walking track. A grant, in the amount of \$130,000 covered 100% of the project costs. The track is important for hosting regional school events, providing youth recreational choices and is a place where people can gather for events. The new four lane, 400m track was installed in 2024. Wawa Mayor and Council would like to thank the Ontario Trillium Foundation, MPP Mantha and municipal staff for making the project possible.
