## Rabbit Blanket Lake Route

A good trip for brook trout fishing, the route follows the South Old Woman River upstream from Rabbit Blanket Lake. Canoe along the main channel to the junction of the river with Kasubeck Creek. Take the right hand channel to a portage leading to Peat Lake.

Access: Rabbit Blanket Lake Campground

To: Surf Lake and return

Length: 16 km return; 3 portages (250 m to 1200 m)

Time: Overnight trip

Portage 2: 1000 m from Peat Lake to Sundstrom Lake. A tough portage, it has both a steep ascent and a steep descent. Caution should be exercised on this portage, especially in wet conditions.

Portage 3: 250 m from Sundstrom Lake to Surf Lake.
