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# Lake Superior

## Sand River Part 3 of 9

Portage 5 is directly across the river from the end of portage 4. Portage 5 avoids low water over cobbles. In times of high water experienced canoeists may wish to run this section of fast water.

Portage 6 is bisected by an old logging road. Anglers occasionally follow this old road to White Spruce Lake.

About 800 m below portage 7 the old O'Connor Road crosses the river on its way to meet with the Algoma Central Railway at O'Connor. Two campsites are now located on either side of the river. Approximately 800 m below these campsites, a fast section of water can be run by experienced canoeists in high water conditions. In low water, line the canoe or use the portage.
