



Belanger Lake Canoe Route

This route is a family or anglers' canoe route, with pleasant scenery and moderately good brook trout fishing. Belanger Lake also has lake trout.

Access: Gargantua Road – about 2 km from Highway 17. Gargantua Road is gated during the closed season, from the end of October through early May. Opening dates may vary depending on weather conditions; the road is not accessible until clear of snow and ice in the spring and it may close earlier due to snowfall.

To: Belanger Lake and return

Length: 13 km return; 4 portages (300 m to 500 m)

Time: Overnight trip
