PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of the Department of Community Services and Tourism's work completed during the month of March 2024, and activities planned for the following month.

BACKGROUND

Key activities in March:

- Hosted the Wawa Ice Fishing Derby
- Hosted the Ladies Bonspiel, Men's Old Timers Hockey Tournament and Northern Ontario Hockey Association Tournament of Champions

CAPITAL PROJECTS

- 2024 MMCC Modernization NOHFC Grant
 - Worked with engineer to complete drawings for gym downstairs
 - Reached out to interior designers about lobby upgrades
- 2024 MMCC HVAC NOHFC Grant
 - Provided CIMCO with additional structural drawings of facility
 - Began scheduling summer construction
- Cenotaph
 - Met with the Royal Canadian Legion, Mike Moore Construction regarding MMCC installation of the cenotaph in front island
 - Mike Moore and Tulloch Engineering have donated services towards the install
 - Staff are working on funding application and quotes for the remaining portions of the project
- Marina Washrooms
 - Issued RFP for washroom replacement
 - Coordinated with IS department for removal of old facility

PARKS AND FACILITIES**MMCC Bookings and Special Events:**

March is the busiest month of the season at the MMCC with large special events taking up much of the month. We hosted:

- Wawa Ice Fishing Derby – 3 days, 1300 participants
- Ladies Bonspiel – 3 days, 32 teams
- Old Timers Tournament – 3 days, 4 teams
- WMHA ToC's – 3 days, 3 teams

- Mixed Curling Bonspiel
- Triples Curling Funspiel
- WMHA Home Games
- Fitness Classes
- Minds in Motion

- Birthday Parties (3)

RECREATION AND EVENTS**Programming – Fitness and Summer**

- Fitness programming
 - Now offering a full spring semester April – June
 - Same course offerings as winter semester
 - Attendance for daytime programs averaging 15 participants
- Summer Plans
 - Tim Hortons again sponsoring Timbits Soccer program
 - Provided 120 uniforms and balls for this summer
 - Youth T-Ball program also being planned
 - Adult softball program taking registrations

Goose Nest Markets

- Mother's Day market in May currently being planned to start off the summer season
- 24 vendors so far
- Road closure planned

TOURISM**Tourism Marketing**

- Worked to redo map in the Wawa Visitor Guide, as well as create a stand-alone map for use at the TIC
- Coordinated with graphic designers for:
 - design of downtown banner program
 - new highway signage
- Drafted an RFP for murals along Broadway and prepared report to Council
- Planned summer flower and banner program

TIC Season 2024

- Reviewed data from 2023 and prepared initial stock orders
- Received some visitor guides from other locations and prepared our order of visitor guides
- Met with Heritage committee to discuss displays inside the TIC

FUNDING**Trillium Sportsfield**

- Worked on the claims process for final funding receipt

Hydro One

- Prepared and submitted grant for Broadway Murals

MONTH AHEAD**Operations:**

- Remove both ice surfaces
- Prepare parks for summer operation

- Plan summer programming (soccer & baseball)
