#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of the Department of Community Services and Tourism's work completed during the month of May and June of 2024, and activities planned for the following month.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Key activities in May:

- Opened Municipal Parklands and Tourism Parks
- Hosted Mine Rescue Tournament
- Opened the seasonal Goose Nest Market on Mothers' Day

#### Key activities in June:

- Prepared for Canada Day
- Opened the Tourist Info Centre
- Started youth and adult recreation programs

#### CAPITAL PROJECTS

- 2024 MMCC Modernization NOHFC Grant
  - Prepared all RFP's
  - Sourced additional funding for score clock based on surplus
  - Scheduled all contract work to start July / August
- 2024 MMCC HVAC NOHFC Grant
  - Completed summer construction schedule
  - Secured production slot for units
- Cenotaph
  - Applied for funding with the assistance of town hall staff
  - Blocked off old cenotaph as additional stones insecure

- Marina Washrooms
  - Completed pour of pad, plumbing hook-ups, and electrical
  - Started construction of facility
  - Some delays due to receipt of doors pushing completion into July

June was the last month before starting construction. We hosted:

#### **TIC Boulevard Grass**

- Staff contacted MTO corridor management rep with a request to cut grass on schedule.
- MTO corridor rep advised that contractor was asked for additional, monthly cuts and denied the request.
- Staff requested the standards for grass cutting and lodged a request to have the standards met, as they were not.
- This prompted a response from the MTO and additional cuts from the contractor completed in June.
- Staff will continue to monitor to ensure that the contractor is meeting the MTO standard and will contact the corridor rep as required.
- Visually the upkeep of the area has improved and staff will work on the Municipally accessible side where needed.
- Staff continue to mow the front triangle area that is MTO property.

#### RECREATION AND EVENTS

#### Recreation coordinator's report: May

- Defined Movement Dance continued their regular programming until the middle of May, then switched to their exam schedule with less bookings per week.
- The regular Spring Fitness schedule continued and ends in Mid June.
- The Mother's Day Goose Nest Market was held in May with 24 vendors. There was a great community turnout with an estimated attendance of 4-500.
- Vendor Callout for Canada Day Goose Nest Market ended, with approximately 35 vendors and organizations registered.
- Preparations and meetings were held with the three wedding bookings for the upcoming summer.
- Youth Timbits Soccer and T-Ball Softball programming began in May, with 100+ youth registered in Soccer and 80+ registered for Tball/softball. This is the highest number of youth ever registered for our summer rec programs.
- Adult Soft Ball league will began in May, with 8 teams registered. It has been a great start to the season.
- The Mine Rescue Competition was held at the MMCC from May 6-10.
- The MHS 70<sup>th</sup> Reunion booked at the MMCC in July has been cancelled due to the low registration numbers.
- ParticipAction planning is well under way, with many events being held in June.

#### **Recreation Coordinator's report: June**

- Defined Movement Dance and Minds in Motion and MMCC Spring Fitness have completed their regular programming for the summer and will return in September.
- ParticipAction was held during the month of June, with the Municipality partnering with WFHT, APH, Early On, SJD, and St. Augustine to offer events to keep the community active. The format of ParticipACTION changed this year, and is only based on events and not individual participation. As a result, we did see a decrease in participation as a whole. The Municipality held our annual Poker Walk Run throughout June, and did have many community members participate.
- Preparations for the Canada Day Goose Nest Market and street Fair were made, and 40 activities and vendors were planned for July 1. Highschool volunteers were brought in to help with preparations.
- Youth Timbits Soccer and T-Ball Softball programming continued in June, as did the Adult Soft Ball league.
- A large wedding was held in the curling rink with 180 attendees.
- Preparations were made for the closure of the gym and many of the rooms for the renovations being held throughout the summer.
