#### Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of the Infrastructure Services work completed during the month of February.

#### Aerodrome Operations

- The big snowblower is broken and awaiting parts. Staff is pushing snow away from runway lights with loader to keep them visible with the recent snowfall accumulations.
- Flights have been increasing a bit with 2 planes on Fridays now. Propair has added the 2 flights on Friday to accommodate Alamos mines.

#### Cemetery Operations

- Nothing to report

#### Landfill Operations

- The electronics bin was taken away to be emptied and replaced with an empty. The bin is emptied approximately every 6 months.
- The steel bin was emptied. This is done every 3-4 weeks depending on amounts brought in.
- Regular pushing and packing continue weekly.
- Winter is normally slower for number of people attending site, will pick up in spring as snow melts and yards get cleaned up.

#### Road Operations

- Regular snow plowing and sanding of roadways and sidewalks.

- Cutting snow banks down and pushing corners back for vehicle view safety.
- The big snow blower has started to blow snowbanks back to the curb. The areas are done in sections at a time working throughout the town site. Some problem areas of flooding are done first in preparation for spring thaw.

### **Water and Sewer Operations**

- Weekly samples of water and sewer are taken and sent to the laboratory for results.
- Continuous cleaning and maintenance of water plant and all the components that keep the system running smoothly. Small break downs and minor repairs are needed as the plant gets older and parts wear out.

### **Capital Projects**

- Purchase of airport plow truck with attachments.
- Preparing for water treatment filters to arrive in March
- Airport project finished up at end of the month.

### **Month Ahead**

Forecasted for March:

- Hauling snow with blower to accommodate spring melting
- Opening up catch basins for spring water run off
- Digging out ditches and culverts
- Praying for end of winter and warmer weather
