Purpose

To request an increase in the budget for the purchase of Water Treatment Plant Filters.

Background

The Wawa Water Treatment Plant houses a series of three skids of water filters which are a critical component in the production of clean water. These filters have now passed there expected useful life. Replacement efforts began in 2022, however, because of supply chain issues we did not receive the first delivery until 2023 at a cost of \$167,012. The remaining project budget for 2023 is \$164,988.

The quote for the second skid of filters has been received and is higher than expected at \$180,112 plus applicable taxes of which the Municipal portion would be approximately \$3,170. This purchase would place spending on this project over the budgeted amount by approximately \$18,294.

Conclusion/Recommendation

Whereas the replacement of the Water Treatment Plant Filters is a project which promotes the continued health and safety of our citizens through the provision of clean water,

And whereas it is believed that prices will continue to increase and supply chains will remain challenged,

Be it resolved that the Council for the Municipality of Wawa authorizes the additional amount of approximately \$18,294 be funded from Municipal Reserves specifically Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund for the purchase of the Water Treatment Plant Filters at a total cost of \$180,112.33 plus applicable taxes.
